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




#### 1. Compared to 2008, by what percentage did your overall ACH volume grow in 2009?






# 2. Compared to 2008, by what percentage did your overall ACH transaction dispute volume grow in 2009?






3. If your ACH transaction dispute volume increased during 2009, to what do you most attribute the increase?






4. Compared to 2008, how did your operational costs associated with managing ACH disputes change in 2009?






5. Compared to 2008, how did your ACH write-offs / losses (in dollars) change in 2009?






6. What impact do you believe new Federal Reserve and OCC interpretations of Regulation E will have on your ACH transaction dispute management costs?






7. Compared to 2008, how did your overall costs to comply with payments-related regulations (Reg E, NACHA rules, PCI) change in 2009?






8. Does your organization have a centralized solution to storing ACH transactions?






# 9. How long does your financial institution store ACH transaction information online?






10. Does your organization have a centralized solution for handling ACH transaction disputes?






11. Does your current solution for handling ACH transaction disputes provide users across departments or geographic operations centers with the ability to access information real-time?






12. Does your current solution for handling ACH transaction disputes provide a centralized repository for storing and accessing imaged documents like WSUPP / WSUD?
